

Creative Writing Competition

- Category I: Classes XI and XII
- Category II: Classes IX and X

Topic for Creative Writing

 Topic will be given on the day of the competition

General Instructions

· No internet services, no books, magazines, reference materials, mobiles, tabs/dongle or other electronic equipment are to be permitted/carried by the participants during the preparation time or while writing.

Preparation Time: 30 minutes Writing Time - 1 hour

Word Limit

- Category I 750 to 1000 words
- Category II 500 to 750 words



Topic & Preparation

- Topic will be announced 1 hour before the commencement of the debate.
- Participants will be accommodated in the school library and may have access to books and journals for preparation.
- Use of internet/any electronic gadgets during preparation time is not permitted.

Speaker

 Speakers will not be allowed to read out from prepared texts and if found reading out from a paper, he/she will be penalized by the judges appropriately.

Categories

- Category I Classes 11 and 12
- Category II Classes 9 and 10

Time limit

- Each speaker will be given 4 minutes (for Category I)
 and 3 minutes (for Category II) to speak.
- A bell will be rung at the end of 3 minutes (for Category I) and 2 minutes (for Category II) to indicate that only one more minute is left for the speaker to wind up his/her debate.
- Another bell will be rung at the end of 4 minutes for Category I and 3 minutes for Category II

Rebuttal

- After every speaker finishes his/her debate, 2 minutes will be allotted for Rebuttal.
- This rebuttal will be in the form of short precise
 questions asked by the members of the competing
 teams on the content of the speaker's presentation.
- In case, no question is asked within 10 seconds, then the judges will give full marks for Rebuttal to the speaker.
