## NEW ASSESSMENT SCHEME (CLASS VI) - ACADEMIC YEAR 2019 -2020

Dear Parents.

Based on the Government policy and CISCE board recommendations, we have updated our Assessment scheme for class VI as formative assessments and summative assessments. The assessment scheme is explained below. **FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT (FA):** 

- > Four Formative assessments will be conducted for all the subjects in each term for 10 Marks; this can be a written test or a class activity as decided by the teacher.
- > Parents will receive the intimation of the FA schedule through regular SMS for each subject.
- > This assessment will happen during the subject period itself and the result of each FA will be published in 'ReportBee APP' for parents' reference.

## **SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT (SA):**

- > Term examinations will be termed as Summative assessments, which will be conducted at the end of the term for 60 Marks. Three summative assessments will happen for an academic year (one SA per term).
- > Timetable and portions will be intimated to the parents well in advance.
- Report card will be issued after every SA during the open day.

- \* Criteria for Values Score: 1. Completion of classwork/homework on time
  - 2. Respect (Teachers, Peers and Parents)
  - 3. Smart turnout to school
  - 4. Regular attendance to school
