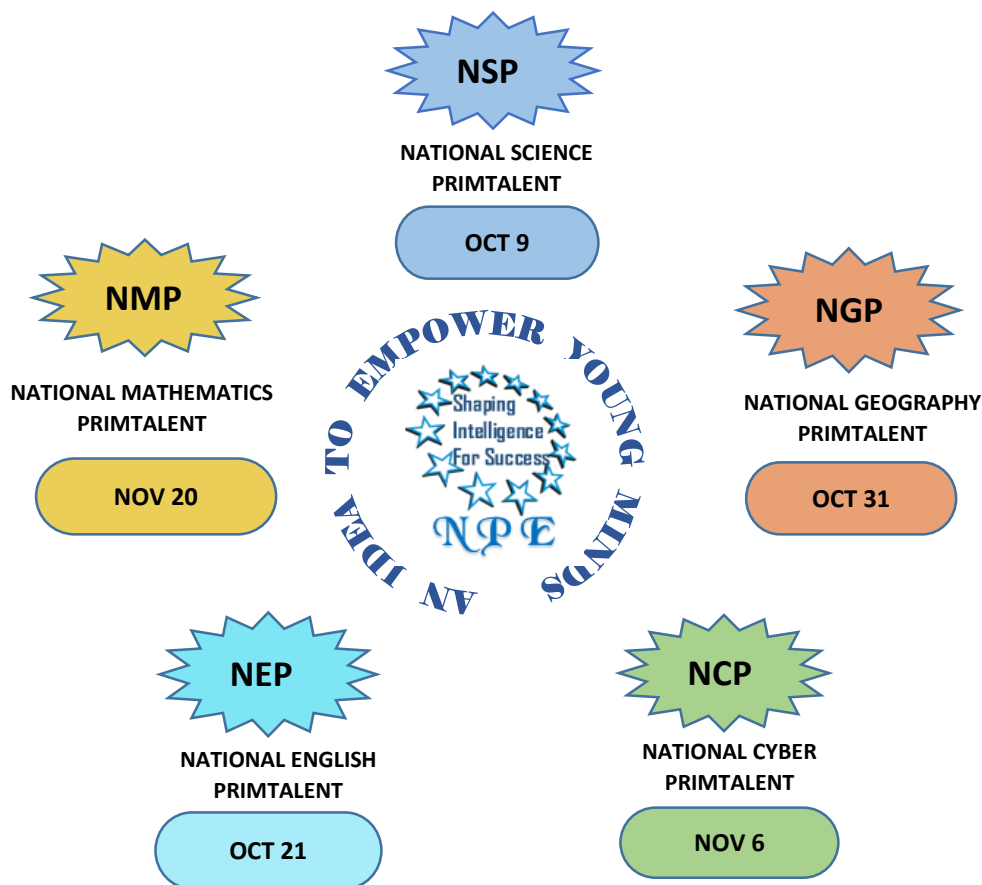
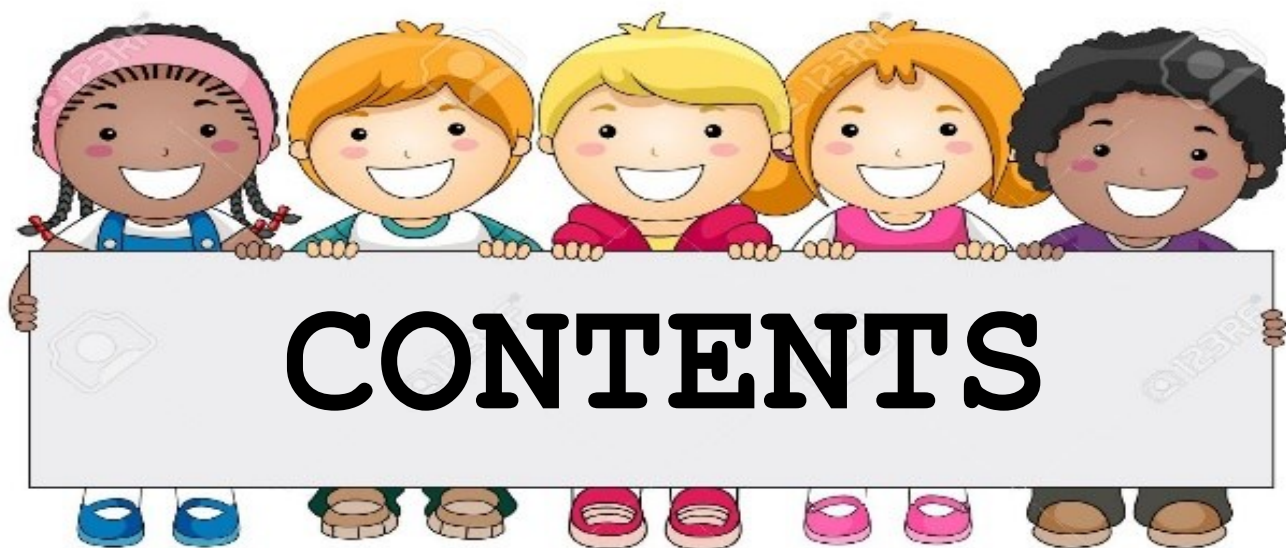

DETAILS OF THE EXAM

- There will be no negative marking.
- An OMR sheet will be provided to the candidates to mark the answers.
- After the examination, the candidates would have to return the OMR answer sheet to the invigilator.

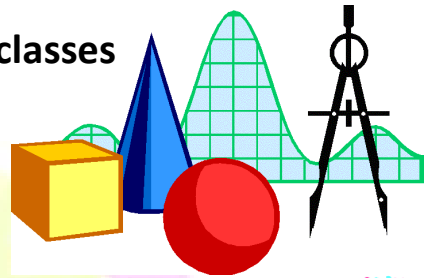

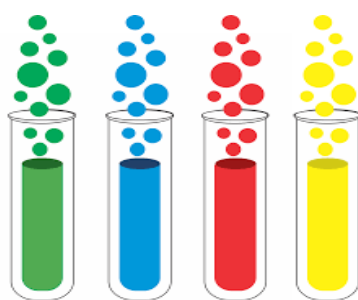

GUIDELINES

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- Each class will have a separate question paper in all the five subjects.
- Class I to III will be **teacher assisted** paper. The invigilator will read all the questions.
- The duration of the examination will be 60 minutes.
- Question paper will have objective type (multiple choice) questions only.
- There will be no negative marking.
- An OMR sheet will be provided to the candidates to mark the answers.
- After the examination, the candidates would have to return the OMR answer sheet to the invigilator.

Last date of receiving fees & candidates details: August 31, 2019

Registration Fee & list of Students:

The Registration fee for each exam is Rs.150/- per candidate, per subject. Schools may retain Rs.25 per student towards honorarium of invigilation and for other expenses. The list of candidates Class wise and Examination wise along with the registration fee should be sent to the NPE Olympiads. The list of the Candidates name should be typed or written in English only. Question papers:

The Question Paper will be Objective Type with four options for each question. The medium of question paper will be English. OMR sheets will be provided to mark the answers. Each question carries 1 mark.

Scores:

Any student scoring above 40% will be considered as successful. The students scoring $\geq 80\%$ will be considered as "**A Grade**", $\geq 70\%$ as "**B Grade**", $\geq 60\%$ as "**C Grade**" and $\geq 40\%$ as "**D Grade**". The student securing below 40% will be considered as "**Under Rated**". The maximum marks for each subject will be 100%.

Certificates and Medals:

All the candidates will be awarded the participation certificate. For each class, the candidates securing "**A Grade**" will be awarded "**Gold Certificate**" along with the rank. The top three candidates, for each class, will be awarded with special certificate along with medals.

Result:

The results will be announced in 7 weeks of time after the Examination.

The Last date for receiving the fees and candidates details is 31/08/19.


