


Sports competitions and activities inculcate the spirit of positive challenge and sportsmanship among the students and prepare them for the life ahead. Sports, and Physical Fitness occupy a place of importance in our curriculum. The students are actively involved in Kabaddi, Throw ball, Kho Kho, Football, Cricket, Athletics, Yoga, Karate, Chess, Taekwondo, Badminton and Other on-field sports activities. Students of Primrose have made our school proud at many Districts, State, National and even on international platforms this year. An opportunity to explore around 21 games was given for which around 210 students participated in various games in regional level, 36 represented National Level and 1 went for the SGFI.

Primrose, at their utmost concern about the health of the students, joined hands with the government health officials and carried out a Leprosy Eradication Programme for them. The strategy was to mitigate the disease by limiting the quantum of infection in the community and minimizing infective sources to break the chain of disease transmission. This awareness programme provided students with a safe learning environment free from threats and includes safe buildings, clean air and water sources and respect for the cultural, linguistic, and socioeconomic diversity of its inhabitants.

Teachers are among the basic components working relentlessly towards the realization of the multiple objectives of Primrose Schools. It is important that this segment of the school remains well-informed about the latest developments in their respective fields. To enable the teachers, perform to the tune of the time, the school organizes regular development programmes. Our management facilitates the training program by the CISCE council to the teachers of various departments on 'Effective ways to setup a Question Paper' in order to equip the paper setting skills.

We intend to go beyond the books by creating a society of learners where students are constantly challenged by teachers as well as their peers so that they outshine in every aspect of their life. Primrose acknowledged its student's talents on three different topics for Annual Day - 2023. Students have excelled in all areas of dance, acting, and speaking. Our aim is to ensure that each child's unique talents are recognized.
