

excitement of the students.








Christmas greetings and wishes were shared by Principal Sir along with delicious sweets.

Our teachers at Primrose provided online classes for our students when children had difficulty reaching school due to the disruptions caused by the cyclone MICHAUNG.


### ONLINE CLASS - UNINTERRUPTED LEARNING
