


Primrose Schools

Topic: Nature Scavenger Hunt










Topic: Weight and Capacity











Students drew and labelled the formation of this cyclone. It assisted the children in describing the atmospheric conditions required for the formation of tropical and extratropical cyclones; analyzing case studies of how geologic and climatic hazards such as cyclones impact coastal systems; and investigating geomorphological changes caused by cyclones.
