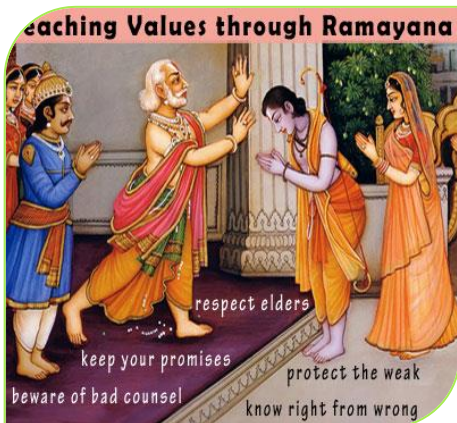

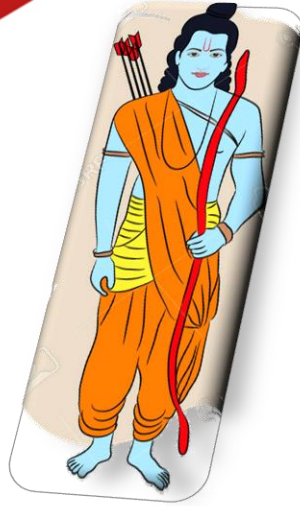


## Respect for Elders, Siblings, and Family Values

# Student Cabinet Election Campaign - by High School Students



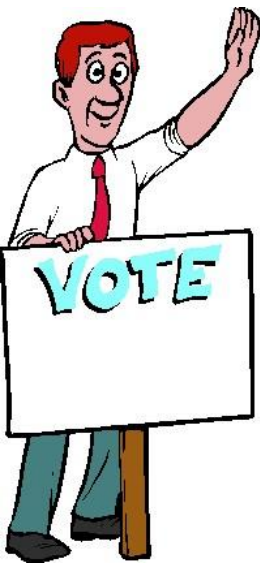
