The teachers made the occasion memorable for the children with a special assembly. The children were treated as gem of a jewel. They enjoyed colorful dance performances by their teachers.

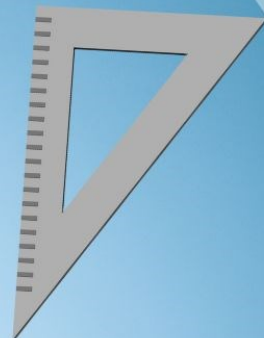
PRIMTALENT MATH

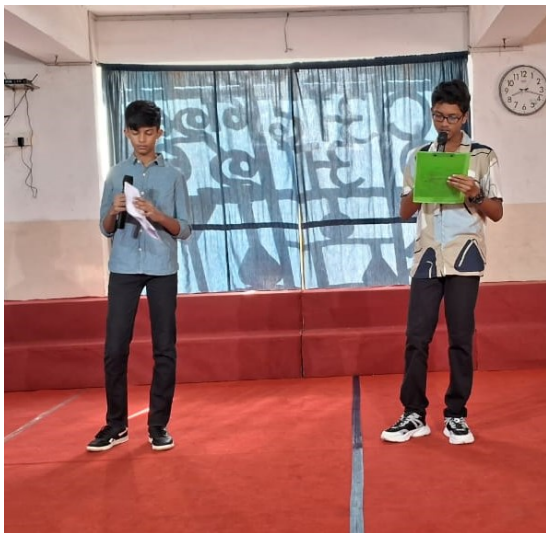
BIOLOGY LAB

GREAT TALKS – BRITISH COUNCIL

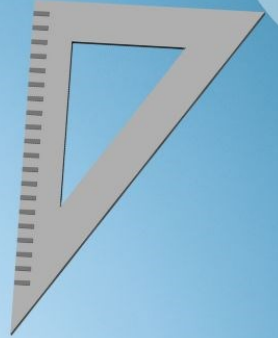

CHILDREN'S DAY CELEBRATION

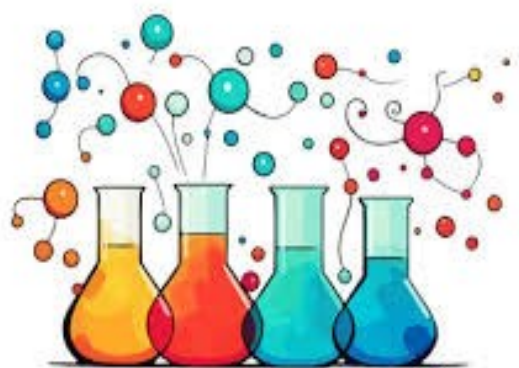

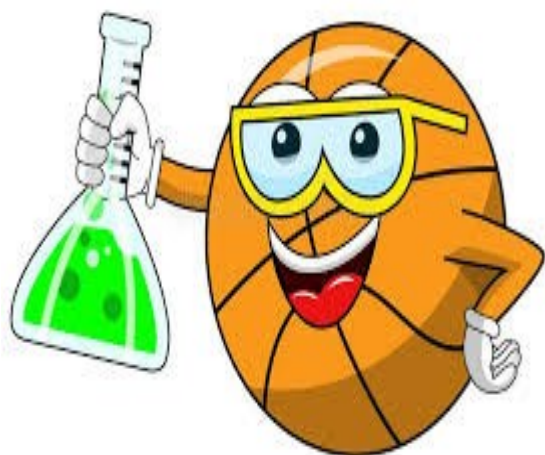

Class X Physical Education Board practical Exam was conducted on 16.11.2024. Students wonderfully showcased the sportsman spirit.





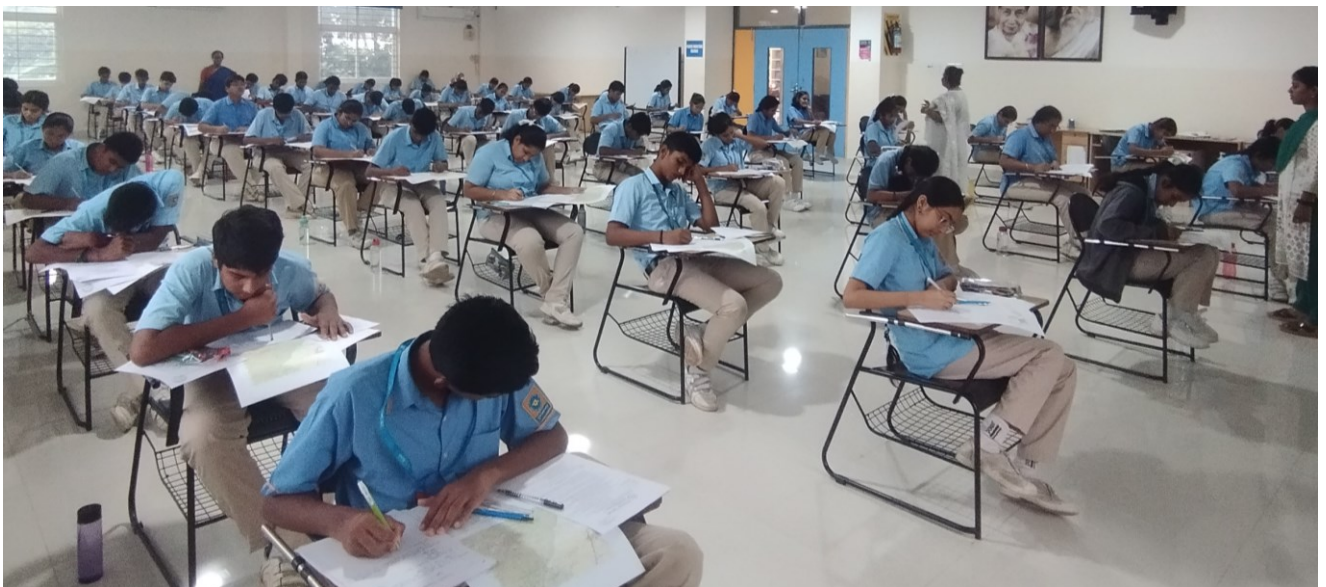

CLASS XII CHEMISTRY BOARD PRACTICAL EXAM

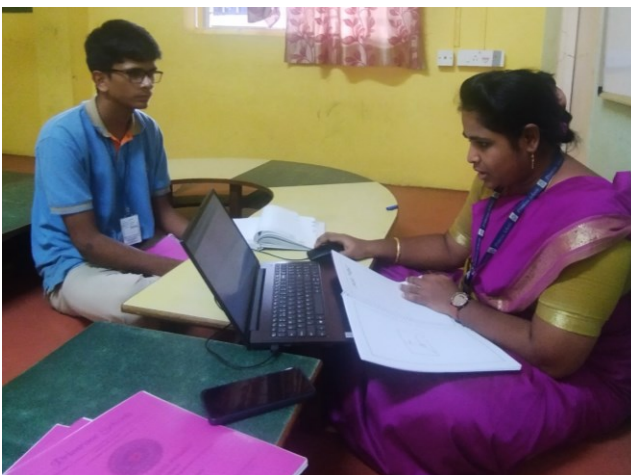

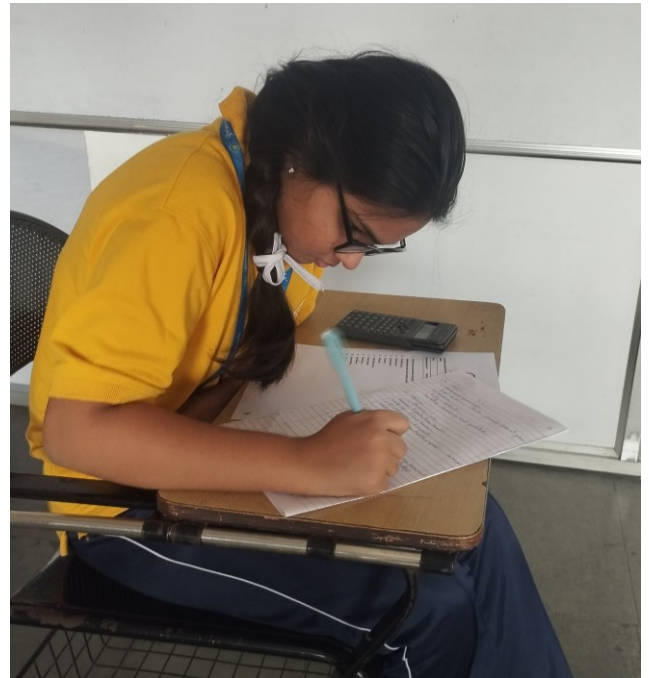
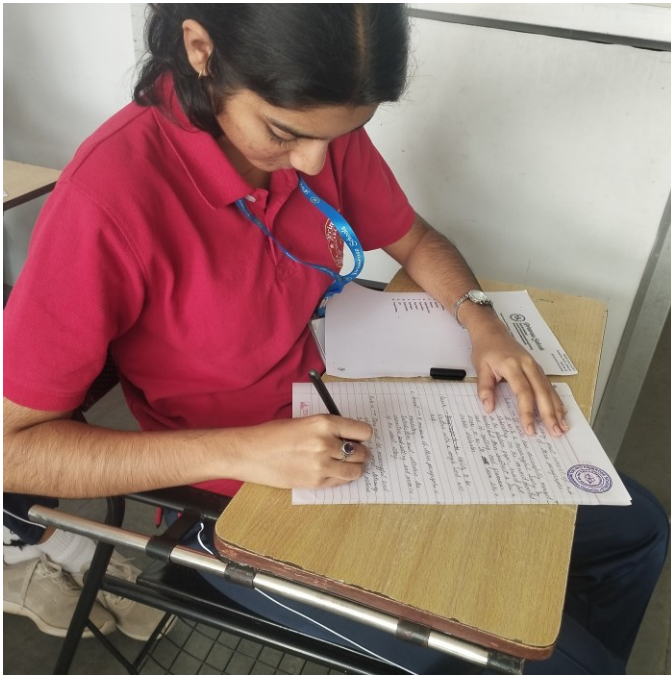




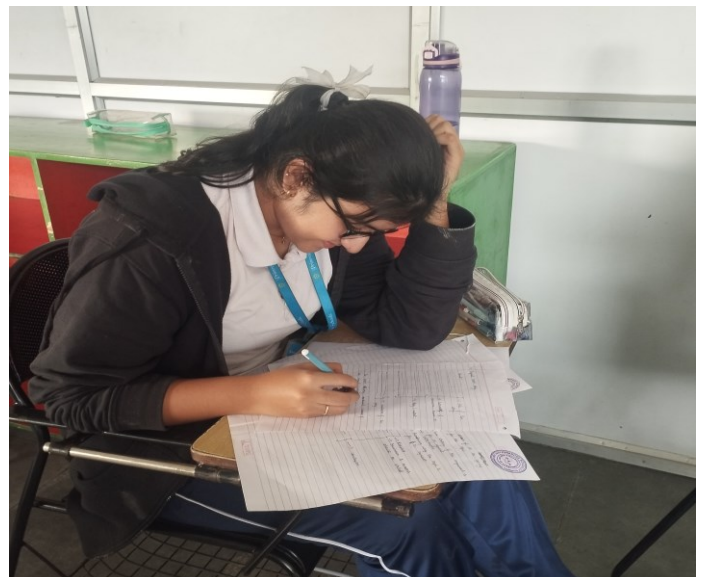
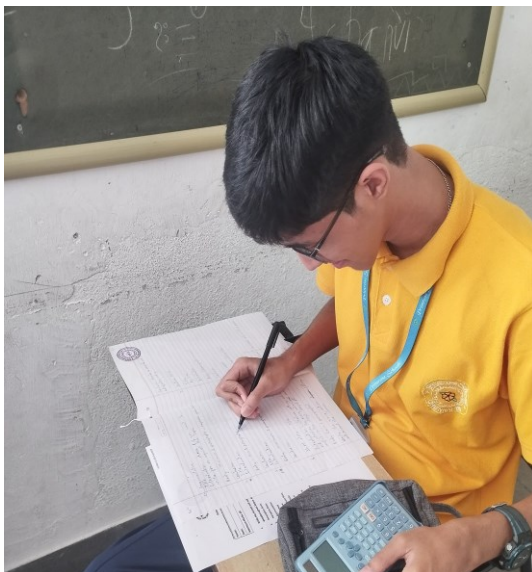
Students of class XII were examined by the members of the Viva-Board. Examiners were fully satisfied by the performance of the students. Students scored full marks in their EVS and MATH viva.

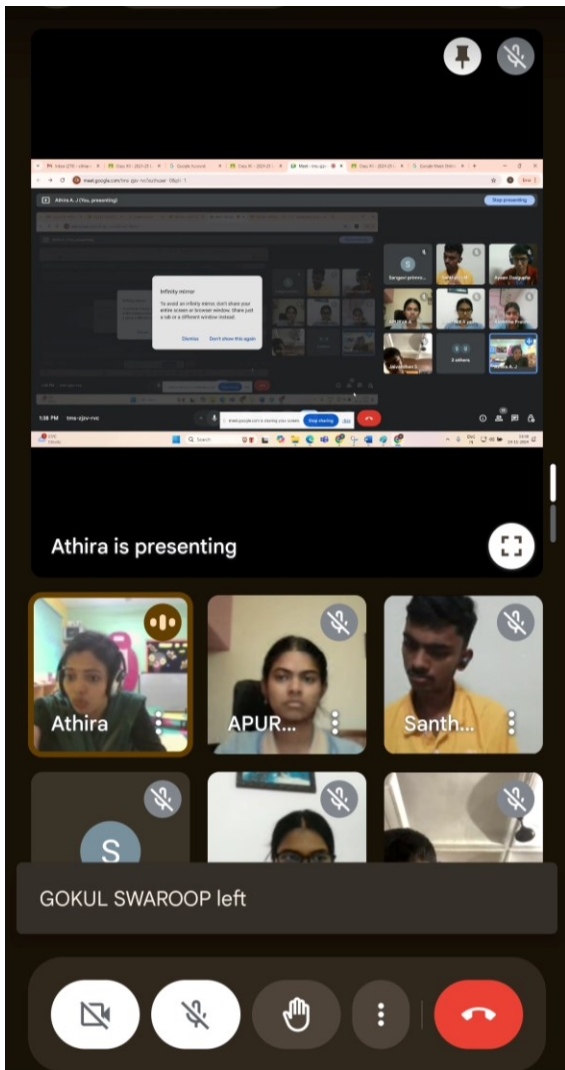


CLASS XII ENGLISH REVISION TEST
