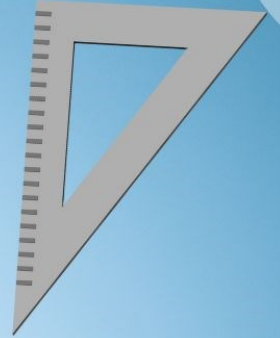


BULLOCK CART RIDE

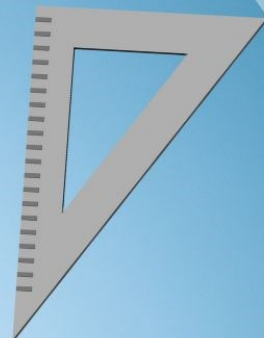

ANNA LIBRARY VISIT

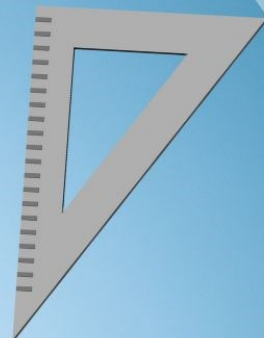

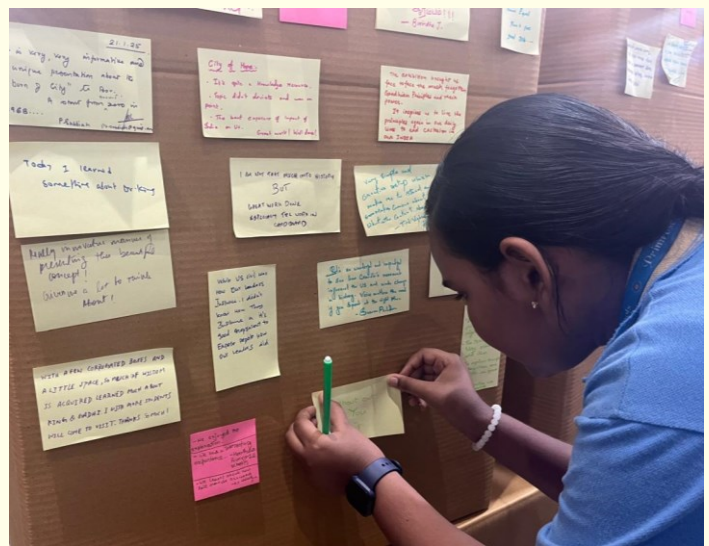


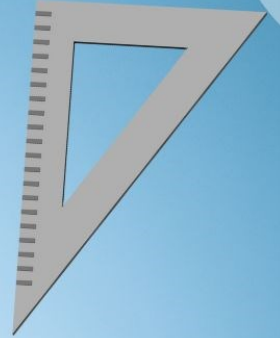
SCHOOL TRIP – ANNA LIBRARY

After that they got feedback from the teachers, made some modifications on their preparation accordingly for the final board exams.



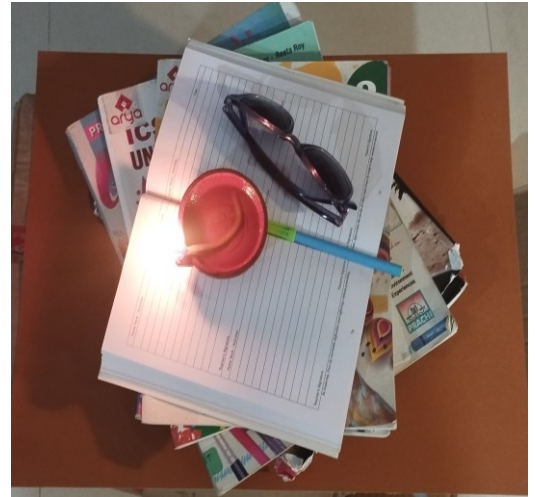
CLASS XII SA II EXAMINATION

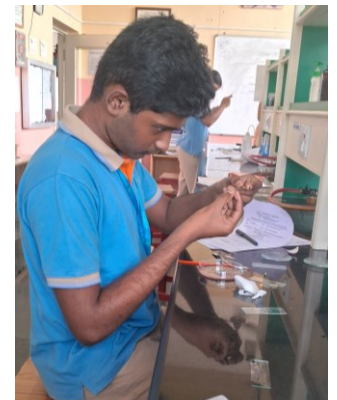
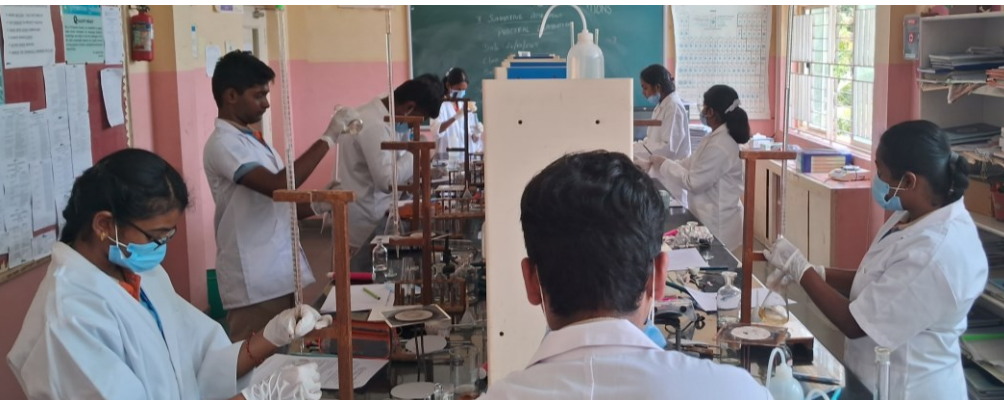
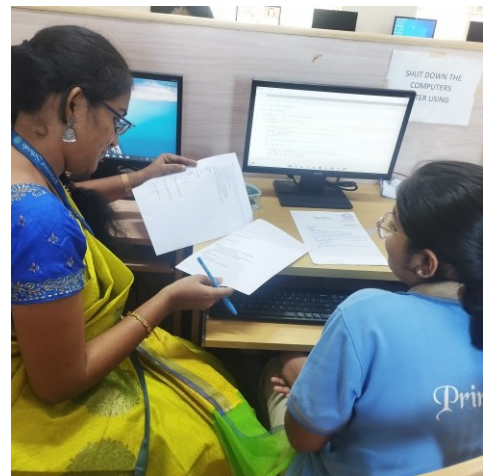
SA II examination was conducted for class XI students. Students kept calm and manage their Given time effectively during the SA II exam.

They focused on class revisions and practice questions related to the topics that are most challenging so that they could perform well in their SA II exam.





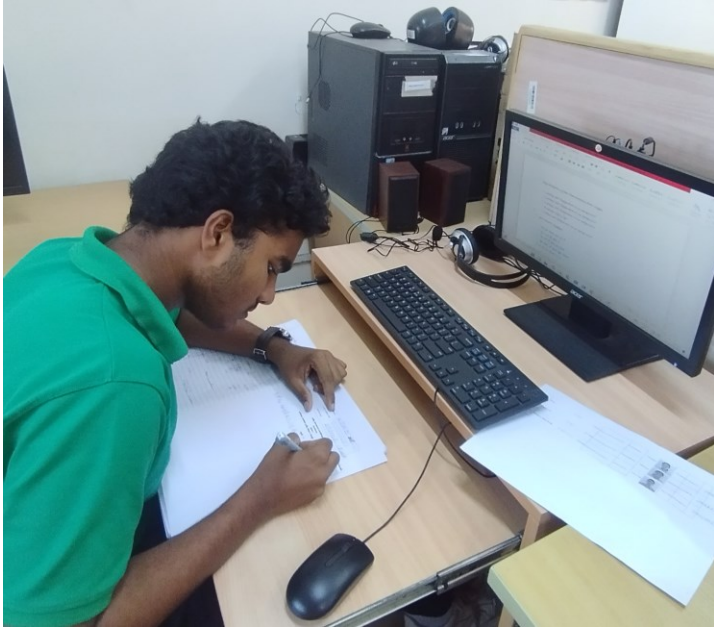
